

POSITION DESCRIPTION – WORSHIP PASTOR

We are looking for a man or woman to join our staff team as our Worship Pastor. We presently have two worship services on Sunday morning.

This is a full-time position that reports directly to our Executive Pastor. This person will spend significant time with our lead pastor and will be a part of our pastoral team.

The person who fills this position will be:

- Growing in their Christian faith and character,
- Willing to serve within the doctrinal commitments of the Church,
- Committed to the mission and values of the Church,
- Teachable and a self-starter.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Create, lead, and manage worship ministry teams that will lead the congregation in weekly weekend worship services.
- Recruit, develop, and deploy worship ministry volunteers including musicians, vocalists, and production technicians.
- Plan and execute worship services in coordination with the lead pastor to meet established objectives.
- Provide relevant and appropriate training for worship ministry volunteers.
- Plan and implement special services including Christmas, Easter, Good Friday, Ash Wednesday, Thanksgiving.
- Build on the strong foundation and current high participation of current worship ministry volunteers.
- Plan, dream, and identify future worship needs and areas for development.
- Oversee production, sound, video, light, and other worship related technology.
- Prepare the annual worship ministry budget and operate within budget constraints.
- Seek opportunities to connect with other worship ministry leaders and encourage cross participation and engagement.
- Other worship and pastoral responsibilities as assigned.
